# Resolution Opposing Oil and Gas Exploration and Extraction in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge

Whereas the Trump Administration rushed to approve oil and gas exploration and extraction in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge, including on the 1.6 millionacre coastal plain, part of a nearly pristine wilderness that is home to migrating caribou and waterfowl as well as polar bears and foxes that live there year-round, marking a major step toward reviving fossil fuel development in an area that has been untouched for decades; and

**Whereas** the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) has found that emissions from fossil fuels are the dominant cause of global warming, and in 2018 89% of global CO2 emissions came from fossil fuels and the fossil fuel industry; and

Whereas climate change poses an existential threat to human life on our planet;

**Therefore be it resolved** that the Santa Clara County Democratic Party urges the incoming Biden Administration to prevent oil and gas exploration and extraction in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge, to the extent possible, and to ensure that any activity that cannot be prevented, due to the Trump Administration rule, is regulated to ensure it is conducted in a manner that protects the pristine environment and diverse wildlife of the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Santa Clara County Democratic Party urges public and private companies to eschew participation in oil and gas exploration in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge and calls on the public to hold companies that engage in such activities accountable for their actions.
