#### Help win Georgia

## Get Involved with State and local Dems

Nowhere is change more within reach than right here in California and Santa Clara County. And no time is better than now to get involved.

To help set the platform and elect statewide officers of <u>the state Democratic</u> <u>Party</u>, file for <u>candidacy</u> as a delegate representing your Assembly District by Dec. 15. This year, all meetings of state party delegates will be held virtually.

To have a hand in choosing your Assembly District's state party delegates, request a **vote-by-mail ballot** by Jan. 11.

If you would like to attend the first 2021 meeting of the Santa Clara County Democratic Party's Central Committee on Jan. 7, check <u>here</u> a few days beforehand for the agenda and links to the virtual meeting. Members of the Central Committee, who decide local endorsements of candidates and measures, were elected in the March primary and will be sworn in at this meeting.
