

**RESOLUTION ON PROMOTION OF RESPECT FOR MARGINALIZED COMMUNITIES AT  
SUPER BOWL LX**

WHEREAS the halftime show for Super Bowl LVI, which took place in Inglewood, California in February 2022, featured four artists with a disturbing history of lyrics that have encouraged physical violence against LGBTQ+ individuals, including, in the case of one artist, lyrics that have explicitly glorified the rape, torture, and murder of LGBTQ+ individuals; and

WHEREAS in advance of Super Bowl LIX in February 2025, the National Football League removed the message “end racism” from one of the end zones for the first time since 2021, signaling a departure from progressive values in the wake of the electoral victory of President Donald Trump, who attended the game in person; and

WHEREAS the County of Santa Clara is a diverse and inclusive community comprised of immigrants, LGBTQ+ individuals, and multi-generational residents and County and City leaders within Santa Clara County share the responsibility to host and/or sponsor community events that reflect the values of inclusivity, equity, and diversity for all people;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Clara County Democratic Central Committee urge the City of Santa Clara and the Bay Area Host Committee to work with the National Football League to promote local diversity, culture, and talents within the County in a manner that reflects the values of our community.
